AN ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER CREATING THE CITIZEN'S LED MONITORING PROGRAM (CLMP) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LA TRINIDAD, BENGUET.

WHEREAS, the Bottom-up Planning and Budgeting (BUB) is a major component of the Empowerment of the Poor Program that will enable people at the grassroots level to strengthen their organizations in order to become vehicles for economic engagement and effective participation in the governance processes;

WHEREAS, just like other programs, there are number of vulnerabilities that can emerge in the implementation of the Bottom-up Budgeting (BuB) Process;

WHEREAS, based on previous experiences, among the design features necessary to mitigate governance and corruption risks are the presence of citizens'-based monitoring and/or social accountability mechanisms;

WHEREAS, in order to monitor BUB project's progress and to improve governance, promote transparency and accountability and strengthen community's voice and empowerment, there is a need to create the Citizen's Led Monitoring Program (CLMP) of La Trinidad, Benguet;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDNA C. TABANDA, duly elected Municipal Mayor of La Trinidad, Benguet, by virtue of the powers vested upon me by law, do hereby create the Citizen's Led Monitoring Program (CLMP) of La Trinidad, Benguet.



Section 2. Functions of the CLMP. The CLMP shall perform the following functions;

- a) Collect, analyze and process data, information and reports of service providers on the status of project implementation;
- b) Facilitate the conduct of community project performance assessment meeting/ workshop, and interface meeting between the community and service providers;
- c) Pinpoint problems and verify information to be submitted for analysis and actions of the CSO partner; CSO assembly and/or LPRAT/RPRAT;
- d) Provide feedback on the remedial actions of the implementing unit/agency and help follow up their implementation;
- e) Help prepare and disseminate reports to the CSO assembly, RPRAT/LPRAT and NAPC-PMO PROJECT IMPLEMENTING UNIT/AGENCY.

Section 3. Effectivity. This Administrative Order shall take effect immediately and shall be valid until revoked or amended.
