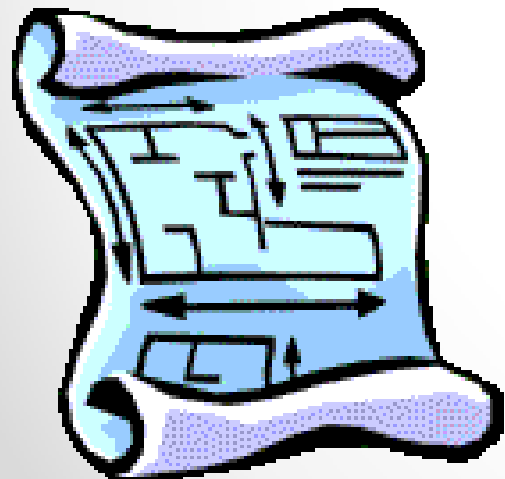


COOP DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

The only Municipality in Benguet with an appointment of Cooperative Development Specialist 1 at the same time designated as Municipal Coop Dev't Officer (MCDO)

Created the La Trinidad Cooperative Development Council through Ordinance No. 15-2014 and supported by Administrative Order No. 3-2015.



Functions of the MCDO

1991 LGU Code and Ordinance No. 15-2014

1. Formulate measures to ensure the delivery of coop basic services and provision of facilities.
2. Develop and implement plans and strategies for coop development.
3. Assist in the organization of coops and assist in the establishment of linkages with GAs and NGOs.
4. Provide technical and other assistance to coops to enhance their viability as an economic enterprise.
5. Maintain and monitor coop data base in coordination with CDA.
6. Conduct IEC on the contributions of coops in the community periodically.
7. Serve as Secretariat to the La Trinidad Coop Dev't Council.

Coop Economic Contributions

(as of 2015)

- 1. Coops employed 298 residents of La Trinidad.**
- 2. Coops released a total of 38,169,089.13 dividends to its members (patronage refund and interest on share capitals) in 2015.**
- 3. Coops allotted 4,385,801.66 for their Community Dev't Fund in 2015.**
- 4. 68 Business Permits were acquired by coops in 2015 while 66 were acquired in 2016.**
