



EXECUTIVE ORDER

No. 09-2022

AN ORDER PLACING ONE (1) RESIDENTIAL BUILDING UNDER TARGETED LOCKDOWN AS PER MESU REPORT IN SITIO BAYABAS BARANGAY PICO FROM FEBRUARY 6 TO FEBRUARY 20, 2022

WHEREAS, Sec. 16 of RA 7160 provides that every local government unit shall exercise powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary to the promotion of general welfare. Local governments shall promote the health and safety, improve public morals, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;”

WHEREAS, in view thereof, there arises the need to issue a lockdown within the said areas to effectively conduct further CONTACT TRACING, ENFORCEMENT OF QUARANTINE PROCEDURES and DISINFECTION;

WHEREAS, one (1) confirmed cases of COVID-19 was recorded in the said area as of February 6, 2022;

WHEREAS, the Contact Tracing Team identified one (5) primary close contacts and one (1) affected household;

WHEREAS, because of the recent development, there is a need to declare the said area under granular lockdown to contain and prevent further infection of COVID-19;

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me as Municipal Mayor of La Trinidad, I, **ROMEO K. SALDA**, after do hereby ONE (1) RESIDENTIAL BUILDING UNDER TARGETED LOCKDOWN IN SITIO BAYABAS BARANGAY PICO FROM FEBRUARY 6 TO FEBRUARY 20, 2022 following guidelines:

1. **GENERAL PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES.** The following minimum public health standards shall be complied with all times:
 - a. Mandatory wearing of face masks
 - b. Observance of physical distancing
 - c. Observance of cough etiquette
 - d. Frequent handwashing with soap and water
 - e. Maintain healthy lifestyle
2. **HOME QUARANTINE AND ISOLATION.** All identified primary contacts of positive cases are ordered to be on isolation. Secondary close contacts are advised to limit their mobility.
3. **ANTI-DISCRIMINATION OF ALL PERSONS CONSIDERED AS “PATIENTS”, HEALTH WORKERS AND FRONTLINERS.** All “patients”, health workers, and frontliners should be treated with respect, compassion and as they perform their tasks. Persons caught and proven to be instrumental in inflicting discriminatory acts against health workers, contact tracers and frontliners shall be imposed corresponding sanctions in proper venues as maybe provided by law.




